Day 1, Thursday, July 10, 2008: BEGIN OUR JOURNEY Depart the United States on our overnight flight to Israel.

Day 2, Friday, July 11, 2008: WELCOME TO ISRAEL! We arrive in Israel, and receive Ayelet Tours staff assistance... We meet our guide and continue to Jerusalem... As we enter Jerusalem, we stop to recite the "Shehechianu!". This evening we welcome Shabbat at the Southern Wall, before gathering together for Shabbat dinner at our hotel. Overnight Jerusalem. (D)

Day 3, Shabbat, July 12, 2008: THE MAGIC OF SHABBAT IN JERUSALEM Breakfast...Join Cantor Levine for Sabbath services at the nearby Conservative synagogue- Moreshet Israel... After services, we go next door to the Fuchsberg Center- the headquarters of the Conservative/Masorti Movement- to share a Sabbath lunch... Enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure or you may choose to join an informal walking tour of this historic neighborhood. (B,L)

Day 4, Sunday, July 13, 2008: HISTORY – MODERN AND ANCIENT After breakfast, we begin a tour of the Old City... Our tour takes us to the Davidson Center, the Southern Wall, and the fascinating Western Wall tunnel excavations... We explore and learn about the Jewish Quarter and the Cardo... This afternoon we will visit Yad Vashem, Israel's memorial to the victims of the Holocaust, where we will visit the moving exhibitions including the Hall of Names and the Avenue of the Righteous Among the Nations... Overnight Jerusalem. (B)

Day 5, Monday, July 14, 2008: SPECIAL TORAH CEREMONY Breakfast...Today we travel to Beit Shemesh to formally present an East Midwood Jewish Center Torah scroll to an Ethiopian synagogue. After the ceremony, we will sit down to a traditional Ethiopian meal accompanied by Ethiopian singing and dancing...This afternoon we will visit Latrun, Israel's outdoor armored corps museum, where we explore the tanks and artillery used by the IDF... Return to Jerusalem for overnight. (B)

Day 6, Tuesday, July 15, 2008: STEPPING INTO THE PAST Breakfast... This morning we travel to the top of Masada... Continue to Ein Gedi... After a hike to the waterfalls, we enjoy a "float" at the Dead Sea, and relax at a mineral bath spa... On our way back to Jerusalem we pass the Qumran caves, where the Dead Sea scrolls were found... Overnight Jerusalem (B)

Day 7, Wednesday, July 16, 2008: TEL AVIV CITY TOUR Breakfast... This morning we discover the secrets of the Ayalon institute... Next we begin our city tour of Tel Aviv, including Independence Hall, where the signing of the Israeli Declaration of Independence took place... Pass by Rabin Square on our way to "join up" with the paramilitary forces at the Palmach Museum... spend time exploring the ancient port of Old Jaffa before we continue to Netanya for overnight. (B)

Day 8, Thursday, July 17, 2008: THE MEDITERRANEAN COAST Breakfast... Depart Netanya this morning and head north along Israel's west coast shoreline, stopping in Caesarea to see the ancient Roman ruins... After lunch (on own), we visit Zichron Ya'akov, where we visit the winery for a tasting and behind-the-scenes look at the wine-making process... This afternoon we visit the unique artists' community at Ein Hod... Arrive in Safed for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

Day 9, Friday, July 18, 2008: EXPLORING THE NORTH After breakfast we enjoy a tour of the Golan, where we visit an old Syrian bunker and the ancient synagogue at Katzrin... Our afternoon includes a visit to Har Bental and take in the panoramic view into neighboring Syria... Enjoy the lush surroundings at the Tel Dan Nature Reserve... This evening we welcome Shabbat and enjoy Shabbat Dinner in the mystical city of Safed... Overnight Safed. (B,D)

Day 10, Shabbat, July 19, 2008: SHABBAT IN SAFED Breakfast. Enjoy Shabbat morning at leisure, with time to join morning services at one of the local synagogues... This afternoon we will enjoy Shabbat Lunch together... Afternoon at leisure... Dinner and Overnight Safed. (B,L,D)

Day 11, Sunday, July 20, 2008: NORTHERN BEAUTY After breakfast we will enjoy some time at leisure for shopping in Safed before travelling to Kibbutz Hanaton, a Conservative-Masorti kibbutz in the north, where we will enjoy lunch and the opportunity to speak to the kibbutzniks about kibbutz life and tour the kibbutz... In Haifa we stop atop Mt. Carmel to take in the views of the Bahai Temple and Gardens before we continue to Herzliya for a festive Farewell barbecue dinner at the home of Miriam and Sandy Goldhaber's children! We will then transfer to the airport for our return flight to the United States. (B,L,D)

Day 12, Monday, July 21, 2008: ARRIVE IN THE UNITED STATES We land in the United States.
