A Place to Worship...



East Midwood Jewish Center, founded in 1924, is a Conservative synagogue affiliated with the United Synagogue of Conservative Judaism. We offer traditional Jewish observance with modern values, offering a variety of services suitable for your needs.

▲ *Daily Prayers*

Morning and evening minyanim are held in our Beth Hamidrash.

▼ *Shabbat and Holiday Services*

Conducted in our Main Sanctuary, we offer a traditional service with full equality for women in all ritual practices. An additional service accommodates members who do not choose fully egalitarian worship.

▲ *Children's Services*

Services are available for children of all ages. They include Primary Congregation, Junior Congregation and Young People's Service.

A Place for Education...

▲ *Talmud Torah*

Our Talmud Torah conducts classes on Sunday mornings and weekday afternoons for children ages 4–13, and provides an education in Hebrew, Jewish values, traditions, synagogue skills and history. Our educational program includes activities for special events and festivals. In addition, we offer Bar/Bat Mitzvah instruction.

▼ *High School of Hebrew Studies*

Our High School of Hebrew Studies for ages 13–17 is unique in its curriculum, including courses in Hebrew, literature, philosophy and issues of importance to adolescents.

▲ *Adult Education*

Each semester a varied program of courses and lectures is offered in the vast spectrum of Judaism: from Torah study to synagogue skills, Hebrew language to aerobics.

The Rabbi offers an annual series of lectures that are a wellspring of Jewish knowledge and tradition. Additionally, we have a series of lectures by guest speakers on contemporary Jewish issues.

On Sunday mornings, our Associate Rabbi conducts a lecture series in Mishna.

Our Cantor teaches a variety of courses and leads informal discussion groups on topics of Jewish interest.

Shabbat Study Sessions offer congregants a stimulating discussion with a kiddush luncheon after services.
